

REIMBURSEMENT OF MEDICAL/ HOSPITALISATION EXPENSES AFTER THE DEATH OF AN OFFICER.

Requests have been received, from time to time, from the legal representatives/family members of the deceased Officer. for reimbursement of Medical Aid, lying to the credit of the concerned Officer's Medical Aid Account at the time of his /her death, against the expenses incurred by the family members for the medical treatment of the concerned deceased Officer. It has now been decided that such requests "the legal representative/family member of a deceased officer for reimbursement of Medical/ Hospitalisation Expenses may be considered by the Authorities competent to sanction these expenses. Such reimbursement shall be subject to the following conditions

1) Medical Expenses or Hospitalisation Expenses incurred by the legal representative/family member towards the medical treatment of th« deceased officer prior to his/her death shall be reimbursed to the extent the balance is lying to his/her credit in the Medical Aid Account or as per his/her entitlement for hospitalisation expenses.

2) Such reimbursement can be claimed by submitting an application to this effect, by the legal representative/ family member of the deceased officer, giving full particulars of medical expenses incurred and accompanied by receipts/vouchers and prescriptions of the doctor.

The requests as above received for reimbursement of hospitalisation expenses shall be sanctioned by the Dept. of Personnel, Central Office, Bombay.
