For circulation among the members of Governing Council of AIBPARC

The first meeting of the Managing Committee of AIBPARC (after the General Body) was held in Ahmedabad on 17th March, 2013. It was a well organized and purposeful meeting which took stock of the events during the intervening period and adopted decisions on future strategies and plan of action. The highlights of the proceedings are mentioned hereunder for information of members :-

1. Comrade G.D. Nadaf, Ex-General Secretary, AIBOC and Com. P.K. Sarkar, President AIBOC addressed the gathering and praised the activities undertaken by AIBPARC within a very short period after its formation and hoped that movement of retirees would take a meaningful shape in near future.
2. The contribution of both the leaders, their continuous guidance and cooperation was considered by the house and it was also decided that both Comrade Nadaf and Com. P.K. Sarkar would be permanent invitees in all future meetings of AIBPARC.
3. The constitution of AIBPARC provides that the leaders of the organisation, being invited by AIBOC, would attend EC meetings, General Bodies etc. of AIBOC. It was a much needed step to explore coordination and cooperation between both the organisations. We have much pleasure to inform the members that Com. P.K. Sarkar, President, AIBOC made an announcement that in all future meetings of AIBOC, Com. K.V. Acharya, President and Com. S.R. Sengupta, General Secretary would remain present as special invitees.

The Representatives of all the affiliates took part in the meeting in a disciplined manner and apprised the House about the growth of membership achieved in last 3 months, organisational activities undertaken by them, the facilities already available in each Bank and further improvements which they deserve to take place. The speakers also put on record that at every Bank the serving organisations are cooperating in an excellent manner with the organisation of the retirees. The house recorded its appreciation for the serving organisations.
5. The meeting took note of the outcome of dialogue that the leadership had with leaders of central trade unions, important politicians, senior bureaucrats and policy makers. The House decided that similar such efforts would be repeated in the months of April and May and in case of necessity, AIBPARC would arrange for protest actions.
6. The meeting discussed threadbare the issue of "coordination" with various other organisation of retirees. It was decided that AIBPARC is always for coordination but with those with whom we have the element of trust, confidence and mutual regard. Coordination on one hand and attacking the fabric of coordination on the other hand cannot go together. It is the need of the hour and all organisations will have to attune themselves in the desired direction.
7. No words are sufficient to convey our thanks to the leaders, activists and veterans of Ahmedabad whose relentless efforts could ensure a really meaningful assembly of Retirees. Special thanks go to Comrade P.S. Jadeja, General Secretary, Bank of India Officers' Associations, Gujrat Unit and his team who took minute care of the members present and extended all possible help to AIBPARC.
8. Friends, the movement of Retirees has taken a new momentum in the city of Ahmedabad. We got a smell and view of it. The Retirees of Bank of India emerged very recently under the banner of AIBPARC and already mobilized 650 members in their fold. They hope to cross the magic figure of 1000 within next 3 months. Our affiliate in Indian Overseas Bank demonstrated their activities in a general Meeting attended by more than 100 persons in the evening of Sunday. The General Secretary of AIBPARC among others attended the gathering.

The House also decided that the next meeting of the Managing Committee will be held on 7th July, 2013 at Bangalore and all the EC members (non-office-bearers) would be invited as special invitees to attend. The EC Members may please take note of it and arrange their travel plan accordingly.

Comrade, the meeting was a grand success. It would go long way to consolidate our strength in Ahmedabad.
