**OUR DEMAND OF PAYMENT OF TA/DA TO CHARGESHEETED OFFICERS AND PROSECUTION/DEFENCE WITNESSES ACCEPTED**

All India Bank Officers' Confederation has been demanding equal treatment to the serving/retired charged sheeted officers and prosecution/defence witnesses attending disciplinary proceedings in respect of payment/reimbursement of TA/DA. Since the Indian Banks' Association did not accept our genuine demands and were denying equal opportunity to the defence, we approached Central Vigilance Commission in 2013. On our further follow up with the CVC, the matter was forwarded to Department of Financial Services, Ministry of Finance for taking action in this regard. In turn Department of Financial Services, Ministry of Finance referred the matter to IBA for its consideration as our demands were in line with the instructions and advice of the Central Vigilance Commission. We are pleased to advise you that the Management Committee of IBA has revisited on the whole issue and has decided that TA/DA will be paid to defence representatives/witnesses (both serving and retired). The communication Ref: HR&IR/CIR/2015-16/E9/M1/1641 dated 19.11.2015, issued by Indian Banks' Association to the Chief Executives of all Public Sector Banks in this regard is enclosed for your reference and records.
