Dear Comrade,

Sub: Issues of Retirees

You have definitely taken note of the following facts:

1) IBA, as per minutes agreed by and between themselves and AIBOC, agreed to appoint an Actuary for assessing the cost factor of different demands of retirees and the said task was expected to be completed by the first week of April, 2016.

2) IBA wrote to all the Public Sector Banks to inform statistical backup related to demands of retirees and most of the Banks furnished the said figures almost a month back. As per unofficial reports, we understood that several Associate Banks were at default in respect of submission of data. IBA issued reminders to them and it is expected by now that they are ready with all the figures.

3) We are aware of the fact that you are in regular touch with IBA and DOFS to ensure follow up measures of different issues of the working employees as well as the retirees. We are hearing from different corners that IBA is in a mood to favourably consider the issues of 100% DA neutralization, improvised family pension and extension of domiciliary expenses to retirees.

You are aware of the fact that the Managing Committee of AIBPARC met at Hyderabad on 14th March, 2016. In spite of our request to President and GS of AIBOC, you could not attend the same as you had some unavoidable preoccupations at Ahmedabad. Com. Harshavardhan represented AIBOC in the inaugural session of Andhra Pradesh & Telengana State Committee meeting and Com. Murli at our request came for a brief period in the business session of the Managing Committee (Extended) meeting. The house took several decisions which included, inter alia, the following :

AIBOC is the only organisation which has been instrumental in re-surfacing the issues of retirees and it is expected that a probable door for negotiation might be opening after receiving the Actuary Report from IBA.

In view of what has been told in the foregoing paragraphs, we request you to kindly apprise us about the real state of affairs prevailing at the industry on the issues referred above. Our organisation decided to maintain its cool for at least a fortnight to see the developments in this regard. After that we are expecting to meet other Retirees' organisations joining the platform of CBPRO and decide further course of action to ventilate our cause of grievances.

Before that, please enlighten us about the knowledge and expectation which you have.
