### **MARCH TO PARLIAMENT ON 9<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST, 2016** **SAVE PUBLIC SECTOR / BANKS – SAVE THE COUNTRY**

Our Confederation has been in forefront in opposing the policies of the Government of the times which lead to destabilize the country through concentration of powers in private hands, foreign investments in strategic sectors, disinvestments, privatization etc. After the present Government took over, implementation of these policies were intensified in the name of reforms. Considering the gravity of the situation, our Confederation formed a Sub-committee to go into the details of the consequences and to suggest a concrete and prolonged agitational programme against so called reforms.
