2nd meeting of Managing Committee (Extended) at Chennai on 20th August, 2016

The meeting was held at IOBOA Academy, Chennai. The meeting started sharp at 10 a.m. with Com. K.V. Acharya, President in the Chair. Com. K. Chandrasekharan was not present as his mother fell sick previous night. The house expressed for her speedy recovery. Com. K. Ananda Kumar, Senior Vice-President, AIBPARC welcomed all members of Governing Council and invited the Office-bearers to the dais. Com. Acharya, in his initial remarks welcomed all the participants and hoped that the meeting would be time bound with avoidance of repetition as much as possible. Com. S.R. Sengupta, General Secretary, also joined the President in welcoming the participants. He requested the President for help of Com. K.B. Ballur, Senior Vice-President, to help him in reading out the notice, minutes of the meeting held on 14th March at Hyderabad and also the Report of the General Secretary placed at Chennai on 20th August, 2016. Accordingly, Com. Ballur read out the papers as mentioned by Com. Sengupta. Members appreciated the efforts of Com. Ballur. Com. S.R. Sengupta, General Secretary, mentioned that though the report was as much exhaustive as possible, something is always left out which is generally tabled at the meeting. Accordingly, Shri S.R. Sengupta congratulated, on behalf of all the participations the first woman Silver Medal Winner Olympian P.V. Sindhu and Bronze Medal Winner Wrestler Sakshi Malik. He also mentioned about the sterling performance of Dipa Karmakar from Tripura in Gymnastics, who won the hearts of millions of Indians. All the participants gave a standing ovation to all of them. The meeting paid reach tributes to late Com. Bihari Patel, Com. K.A. Appalaraju, Com. Sushil Ghosh of AIBEA and also for the lives lost in terrorist attacks in different parts of the globe and also the lives lost because of natural calamities. A minute's silence was observed in the memory of departed souls. Shri K.V. Acharya, President, thereafter invited the members of the Managing Committee for deliberations on the reports of the General Secretary.

Detailed deliberations followed thereafter. In initiating the discussion Shri S. Kupuswami of Indian Bank Retirees Organisation mentioned about the need for improvement in the Medical Insurance Scheme and more particularly about the adoption by those members who did not do it so far. - a) The role of AIBRF towards bank pensioners and retirees movement as a whole
- b) Apprehension by representatives of Associate Banks regarding the facilities available to them after merger

- c) IBA communication for formation of Grievances Cell at different banks level not implemented as yet
- d) Medical Insurance Scheme
 - (i) Non availability at domiciliary facility
 - (ii) Extension of the scheme by 30th September – details to be circulated by IBA
- e) Massive NPA and implications thereof
- f) Formation and a committee to compile the progress of the court cases
- g) Formation of State Committees in States where it has not been done as yet
- h) Studying of Provident Fund and Pension Funds by the representatives of Employees and Officers in different banks and to send reports of those to AIBPARC

The General Secretary assured the members that all the problems as raised would be looked into by the organisation. Where actions are demanded, AIBPARC will take up with IBA. Shri A.N. Krishnamurthy, the newly elected General Secretary of Canara Bank Retirees Association proposed vote of thanks to the house. He especially mentioned about the hospitality extended by IOBOA Academy for making the stay comfortable and atmosphere congenial. The meeting came to an end sharp at 5 p.m. with vote of thanks to the Chair and to all concerned.
