Respected Sir,

Sub: Meeting with you on 17th April, 2014 – Submission of Charter of Issues

We invite your kind attention to our letter No. GS:151 dated 10th April, 2014 wherewith we had enclosed the Charter of Issues pertaining to Pensioners and Retirees. We thank you for the kind courtesy extended to our President Com. Bihari Patel when he met you on 17th April, 2014. Your words of encouragement and assurance to look into the issues confronting the Pensioners and Retirees of our Bank gave a lot of satisfaction to us. In this regard, we submitted a detailed Charter of Issues facing the Pensioners and Retirees community and fondly hoped that many issues would be resolved within a reasonable time. To ensure speedy disposal of the various issues, we had submitted a copy of the Charter of Issues to General Manager (Personnel), Asst. General Manager(Personnel Administration Division), Department of Personnel and to the Senior Manager (Terminal Benefits Division), Department of Personnel.

Though more than two months have passed since submission of the Charter of Issues, we are sorry to bring to your notice that the Department of Personnel, Central Office, has not chosen even to send an acknowledgement of our letter. Out of the various issues submitted in the Charter, we note that only the request of Com. Tridibnath Mishra for

becoming a member under UBIREMAS and that of Com. Jagirdhar for payment of difference in pension have been considered. We are not aware of the disposal of other issues.

In our Charter of Issues, we had requested for the appointment of a Liaison Officer for Pensioners and Retirees so that grievances, if any, could be taken up with him directly for redress. We had mentioned that issues referred to the Department of Personnel are not being attended to within a reasonable time and in case of delay, we are forced to approach the same Officer for redress of our issues. Our stand is vindicated that many issues raised by us have not been attended to even after lapse of considerable time. We now reiterate our demand for appoint of Liaison Officer (other than an Officer in the Department of Personnel) so that issues faced by the Pensioners and Retirees would be resolved with least delay.

Though we do not wish to encroach upon your valuable time with our pending issues, we are constrained to write this communication. We earnestly request you to pass on suitable instructions to the Department of Personnel, Central Office to resolve all the issues referred to by us and send a detailed reply. We are sure that you will protect the interests of Pensioners and Retirees for their invaluable contribution to the growth of the Bank.
