Triennial General Body Meeting as well as Central
Committee Members Meeting of our Association

The Triennial General Body Meeting of our Association was held on 26th
February 2017 at Moreshwar Sabhagruh, Near Karishma Society, Karve Road,
Kothrud, Pune . It was presided over by Shri Nitin Desai, President All India Union
Bank Pensioners and Retirees Federation.

The Conference began with prayer "Shri Ganesh Vandana" by Mrs
Savita Oak, the anchor of the function and thereafter she requested the house to
observe 2 minutes silence in memory of our departed colleagues and other
prominent personalities.

The Chief Guest, Shri Deepak Kamble Dy General Manager, NRO, Pune,
Shri N Govindarajulu-General Secretary AIUBPARF and Shri Nitin Desai- President,
AIUBPARF were formally invited to the dais by the principal office bearer of our
Association and they were presented with floral bouquet. Shri S G Sukenkar,
President UBPARA and other Office Bearers of the Association welcomed the
guests and presented them with floral bouquets. The Association honoured Shri
Nitin Desai, President AIUBPARF and Shri N Govindarajulu General Secretary

The Association also honoured Shri A.C.Sule, Retired General Manager, Shri R B Raswalkar-Retired General Manager and Shri V S Dole-Retired General Manager and presented them with floral bouquets. Shri S G Sukenkar, President of our Association and Shri D G Patil General Secretary are co-opted as Vice President of our Federation(AIUBPARF). They were also felicitated by the dignitaries. The office bearers of AIBOC Shri Abhang and Shri Shrimant Jagtap and Shri Rupesh Nagmode of SC/ST Welfare Association were also felicitated

More than 200 delegates and observers from Pune, Nasik, Ahmednagar, Kolhapur, Aurangabad, Jalgaon, Jalna, Solapur District attended the conference and exhibited their support and confidence to the Association. Large number of Senior Executives and other activists also attended the Conference. The colorful banners and placards with slogans of Retirees long pending economic pending demands has drawn the attention of the public at large. The gathering was spontaneous throughout the day.

* **Shri D G Patil**, General Secretary welcomed all the dignitaries present on the dais as well as welcomed the Senior Executives and members. There after Shri Patil informed about the history and foundation of the UBPARA. He presented report to the house highlighting the various activities carried out by the Association during last 3 years.

* **Shri S G Sukenkar**, President, UBPARA briefed the house that due to the efforts of the activists membership of the Association crossed over 450 and appealed all members to continue such efforts for membership to strengthen our Association. He informed the house that the Association has carried out various activities such as Publication of Souvenir which contains details about Provident Fund, Gratuity, Reverse Mortgage, various forms, details of Holiday Home etc. The Souvenir is very useful for everyone and handy. He also informed that the Association also came out with Booklet on Medical Insurance Scheme and also Tie up arrangement made with M/s Dhande Pathlab and Diagnostic Pvt Ltd. The Association with help of Rotary Heritage Club, Pune also arranged for members

A Classical Musical Programme of well known singer Shri Mahesh Kale., which helped us for the drive of fund raising of our Association.

* **Shri A C Sule**, Retired General Manager in his opening remarks said that he was happy to be present in the meeting to witness such a good gathering of members and spoke about wonderful work being done by the retirees and expressed that each one of the employees were instrumental in bringing up our bank to this height and appreciated the efforts taken by them.

* **Shri N Govindarajulu**, General Secretary, AIUBPARF addressed the gathering. He Informed the house that the Maharashtra Unit has done wonderful work in respect of mobilization of membership and become No.1 as far as membership is concerned in India. He further spoke that the second Pension option was given due to the sincere efforts of the and AINBOF & AIBOC and the Federation is pursuing the long pending issues of Retirees such as 100% D A Neutralization, Updation of Pension, Increase in Family Pension and setting up of separate Welfare Fund for retirees. He also informed the house that the Federation has raised 30 issues with the Top Management and the matters are being pursued.

* **Shri Nitin Desai**, President, AIUBPARF focused on major issues about post retirement benefits and demanded that 25% of the profit should be distributed towards the welfare of the Bank Employees including retirees. However Management has not responded so far. The present Government is also not doing anything for us for which we have to continue our fighting. We have to fight out own battle and help ourselves. He said the strength of the Association is always measured by membership hence membership drive should be an ongoing exercise.

* **Shri Dipak Kamble**, Dy General Manager, NRO, Pune informed the house that the Region has crossed the business mix of Rs 41000 crores and congratulated every one who has helped in this task. He briefed that post demonetization no untoward/unpleasant incidence or fraud took place in the

Region which is an achievement and requested all the retirees to share their experiences with the working employees to improve their working and Bank business as well.

* **Shri R B Raswalkar**, Retired General Manager expressed that the working Unions should also consider the requirements of the retired employees at the time of negotiations/revision of the pay scales and long pending issues such as Updation of Pension, 100% Neutralization of D A, and increase of Family Pension etc. He also said that the retired employees must unite to fight for achieving the long pending genuine and legitimate demands.

* **Shri B B Yadav**, Chairman, UBPARA expressed that we are fighting with the Top Management legally at the Organization level. In fact our demands should be minimum and pressure should be maximum but in reality it is reverse. We lack in militancy and Management exactly want this. Our financial health is not strong. We have to collect donations for the same. Funds raising is great issue for us. Since all the members are not using social media such whats app etc. we should issue hardcopy of circulars. New retired employees should come forward to lead the union successfully and our existing leaders should encourage them. He further noted that many retirees are having dual membership they are members of our Association as well as of other retirees union. To bring uniformity it has been resolved unanimously in the Central Committee meeting that our members should discontinue /resign the other retirees union membership with immediate effect and this exercise should be completed as early as possible. A good response was observed from the present members and this process was initiated immediately. Mr Yadav further appealed the gathering to willingly forward such resignation letter to our principal office bearers.

* **Shri V M Kulkarni**, Organizing Secretary, UBPARA while expressing vote of thanks informed about the best wishes conveyed by M Vyanktesh, General Manager, FGMO PUNE for this meeting and he also noted with pride that all the executives of our Zone are members of our Association.

There after the inaugural session ended.

CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS MEETING

The delegate session began after lunch. Shri D G Patil, General Secretary informed the members that the meeting of Central Committee members was held yesterday i.e. on 25.07.2017 at Hotel Raviraj, Erandvane, Pune. Com. Nitin Desai, President, AIUBPRAF and Shri N Govindarajulu, General Secretary and the Central Committee members were present at the meeting. The report of the General Secretary was finalized as well as other resolutions such as Onetime Lifetime Membership was modified and appointment of Statutory Auditor M/s S R Dabke & Associate were passed at the meeting.

DELEGATE SESSION/BUSINESS SESSION

Shri D G Patil, General Secretary read the minutes of Foundation Conference held on 01.12.2013 which were confirmed unanimously. Thereafter Shri Patil, presented the report to the House. Shri Patil made elaborate placements covering all the points of the Report. He also explained the need for more involvement from all members in building up an effective movement under UBPARA. After inviting discussions on the report, the same was unanimously adopted.

-- The audited accounts of the UBPARA as of 31.03.2014, 31.03.2015 and 31.03.2016 as well as unaudited accounts upto 31.12.2016 were presented to the house by the Treasurer Shri D B Kulkarni, and were also unanimously adopted.

--The next agenda was Appointment of Statutory Auditors was taken up. The 3 year term of the existing Statutory Auditors M/s S V Potdar & Associate is completed. As such appointment of New Statutory Auditors is necessary. The Central Committee in its meeting dated 25.02.2017 has already passed resolution for appointment of M/s S R Dabke and Associates for a further period of 3 years and the same is adopted by the house unanimously.

--Thereafter another resolution passed by the Central Committee in its meeting dated 25.02.2017 for amendment in onetime life membership fee to Rs 1500 from Officer cadre retiree and Rs 1000 from Award Staff Retiree, is adopted by the house unanimously.

--It was decided to add a post of ORGANIZING SECRETARY in our Executive Committee during the first Central Committee on 01/12/2013. This amendment in the constitution was approved in this General Body.

Thereafter, the existing body of office bearers was declared as dissolved.

Shri Dole, Retired General Manager was nominated as Presiding Officer to carry out further proceedings of our Association.

A panel of Office-bearers and Central Committee Members was proposed by Shri Dole and thunderously seconded by the house. Thereafter, the new team of Office bearers and Central Committee members was unanimously declared elected.
